



Medical Indications:

Diets with these nutritional modifications have been recommended for dogs with the following conditions:

- Obesity (weight loss and weight maintenance)
- Constipation
- Fiber responsive colitis
- Diabetes mellitus in overweight dogs
- Hyperlipidemia in overweight dogs

Medical Contraindications:

- Conditions associated with catabolic states



Feeding and Administration:

Animal feeding tests using Association of American Feed Control Officials (AAFCO) procedures substantiate that Purina Pro Plan Veterinary Diets OM Overweight Management Dry Canine Formula provides complete and balanced nutrition for maintenance of adult dogs. OM Overweight Management Canned Canine Formula In Sauce is formulated to meet the nutritional levels established by AAFCO for maintenance of adult dogs.

The following feeding program is recommended as a guideline only, with discretionary clinical adjustments for obesity management. The suggested daily food intake for weight loss is based on the dog's current weight, average caloric requirements and a desired weight loss of 2% of body weight per week. Daily food intake should be adjusted every 4 weeks.
